2. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to compete in any County Championship a player must:

- a. be of Amateur Status as defined by the R & A.
- b. be a member of a Member Club affiliated to the Union, which has fully paid its subscription to the union or has agreement to defer payment until a date mutually agreed.

To be eligible to represent the County in matches a player must:

- a. be of Amateur Status as defined by the R & A.
- b. be a member of a Member Club affiliated to the Union, which has fully paid its subscription to the union or has agreement to defer payment until a date mutually agreed.
- c. not represented another County affiliated to the Scottish Golf Union during the preceding twelve months.

7. MATCHPLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

The top 16 from the previous year's strokeplay championship shall be invited to compete in the matchplay championship. Held over 1 weekend in April the draw shall be seeded as follows. Seedings will be decided by better second round if strokeplay total is the same.
